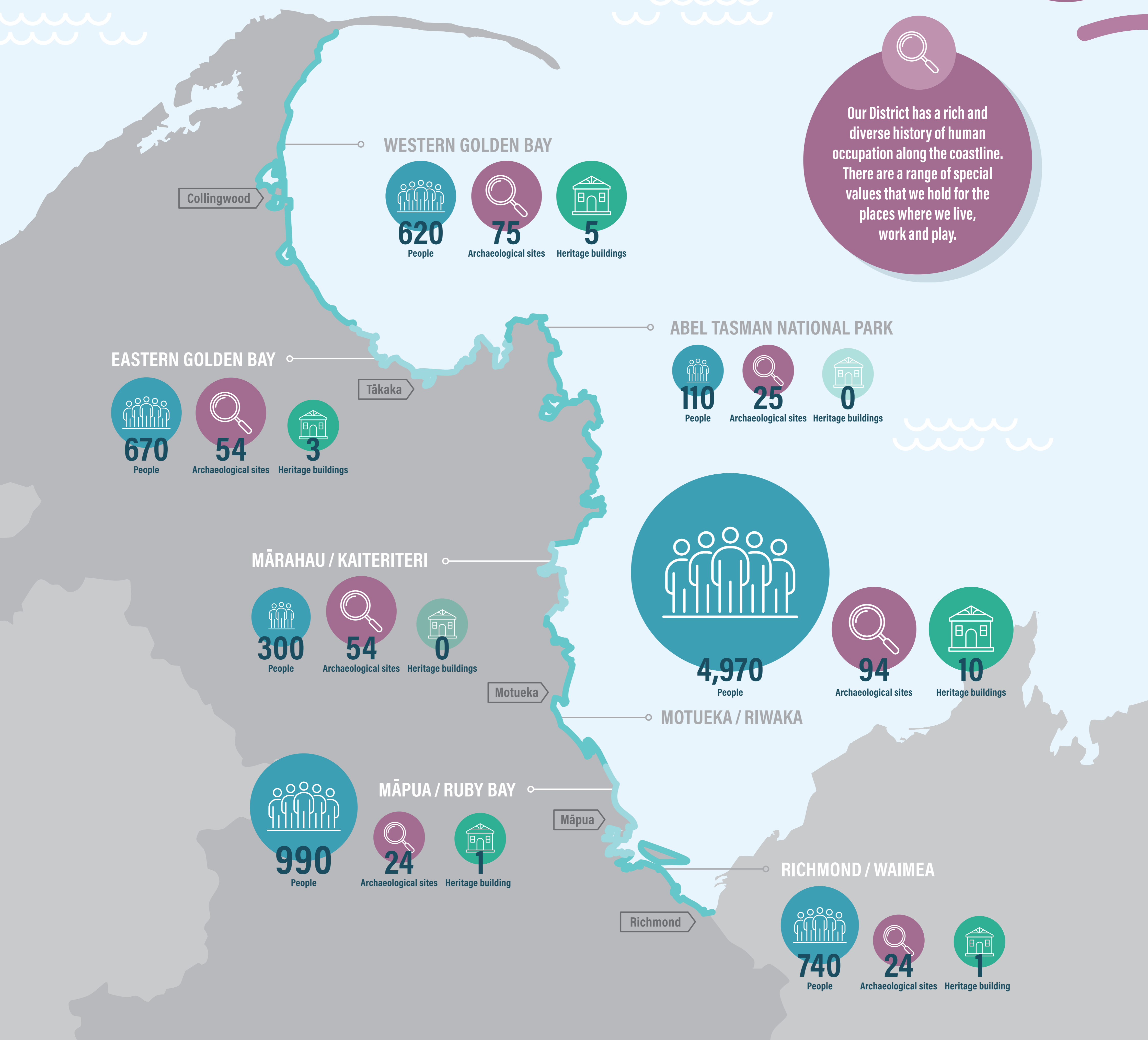


Coastal Management: What's at risk?

Our human environment

This poster illustrates some of the human (social and cultural) values that are at risk from a 1% AEP coastal storm tide and 2m sea level rise. A 1% annual exceedance probability (AEP) event has a 1% chance of occurring in any year. This information comes from Council's Coastal Risk Assessment (2020) which outlines the vulnerability of Tasman Bay/Te Tai o Aorere and Golden Bay/Mohua to climate change impacts.

Our District has a rich and diverse history of human occupation along the coastline. There are a range of special values that we hold for the places where we live, work and play.



Our risk assessment information draws on the methodology used for the Ministry for the Environment's National Climate Change Risk Assessment for New Zealand Arotakenga Tūraru mō te Huringa Āhuarangi o Aotearoa (2020).
