Our submission is in relation to the discharge of contaminants to land, specifically from backfill material associated with the proposed gravel extraction from the berm of the Motueka River and on the landward side of the stop bank at Peach Island (consent application RM220578).

My submission is— We oppose the granting of a discharge consent as we don't believe the processes CJ Industries propose to mitigate any effect on the shallow aquifer can be followed in a practical sense when backfilling. Ground water will likely inundate the backfill when water levels increase during high river flow periods.

Their supporting hydrological report is theoretical, the actual effect can't be determined before a consent is approved, these effects could be detrimental to surrounding bore owners for years to come.

There are inconsistencies in the application regarding the quality of backfill, they state road cuttings and slip material will go into backfilling, then it is stated all material will be screened offsite before being used as backfill.

There is no requirement to have an independent 3rd party monitor the proposed backfill everyday of operation.

There is no practical way to remediate our drinking water if contamination does occur.

Their proposal allows for a change of quality of our drinking water within excepted NZ water standards. This is unacceptable, we already have pristine naturally filtered, great tasting water that could be altered in composition considerably, only to benefit CJ Industries commercial gain.

I seek the following decision from the consent authority: that the application for consent to discharge contaminants to land at the gravel excavation site at Peach Island Road be declined.

There is currently significant community/TDC/DOC and iwi focus on restoring the Lower Motueka Catchment (and full Catchment). TDC are currently in discussion with iwi on their vision for the lower area- in particular from the Motueka State Highway Bridge up to Peach Island. With potential cycle way, and river access for community swimming and enjoyment. The goal is to connect the community back to the awa so they will care for it in the future. To consent contaminated water discharge and allow back fill (which CJ industries have a history of doing with contaminated items) just above this potential site is a contradiction of the communities goals.

Any contaminated backfill, water will end up in both the River and the Motueka Goundwater, the implications of this will effect the whole township. CJ industries have brought two futher properties (under different family member names) next to this first proposed site, their long term plan is to do gravel extraction at all three properties. Allowing this one will set a precedence for future.

Public percentration to date is that TDC is the council that puts profit over the environment, this is paticularly obvious when we sit next to NCC that are much more environmentally focused. It is time to change that

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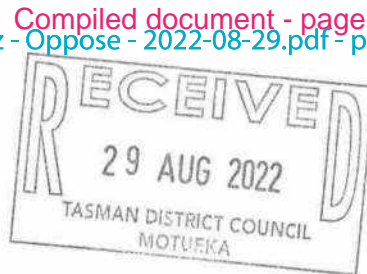

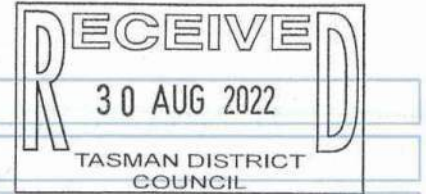



Note 1.

I oppose the granting of the RM220578 on the following grounds :-

A/ This land is zoned Rural 1 land, and therefore should not have any other type of use

B/ adding contaminants to a fragile soil structure and volatile water table level would be a disaster. In the last 2 years this area has flooded extensively. The water table has risen, so making gravel extraction not viable for long periods of time after heavy rains.

The soil is very permeable, and with the increasing amounts of rain we expect to receive due to "climate change", these contaminants will rapidly leach into the ground water, polluting the ground water, all the wells downstream, and eventually out into the Motueka River. The Iwi has just issued a rahui for the whole of the top of the South Island due to contaminants leaching into the waterways and then onto the foreshore and out into the ocean. We as a nation cannot continue to pollute our waterways, stored water or groundwater.

C/ I note there is no mention of polluting dust from the proposed quarrying. This will travel many meters, again polluting the river and surrounding orchards and fields.

D/ the stop banks around the proposed operation were built in the 1950's, and not to current standards. There is evidence the soil level has risen over the years due to flooding, and now their resultant maximum flood level protection has diminished. Also due to their construction, it would be disastrous to quarry anywhere near these failing stopbanks.

Note 2.

If the RM220578 is allowed I would like to see these amendments

Under Application for Consent.

Item 20. "Any backfill material sourced from offsite should only be brought to site by the Consent Holder and/or it's contractor, and any shall be pre-screened for compliance with the cleanfill requirements before being brought to site."

A/ Section 4.2/2 of the "Peach Island Proposed Quarry: Hydrogeology. Appendix D.

"wet fill will be laid aside & not inspected until dry".

This should not be allowed, and wet fill should be rejected and not allowed onsite. This section would allow the storage of untested backfill on the quarry site.

This also is a breach of Item 20 above.

B/ "Any clean fill displaying a visual or olfactory evidence of contamination will be either set aside chemical testing or rejected"

This should not be allowed, and fill of this description should be rejected and not allowed onsite. This section would allow the storage of untested backfill on the quarry site.

This is also a breach of item 20 above.

C/ I have concerns of how CJ Industries are going to monitor :-

1/ speed limits on both the access road and the main highway

2/ all environmental tests. The TDC appears to be very under resourced in this department.

D/ if the well water is contaminated, how are CJ Industries going to supply the affected households.

E/ the fines for not complying are a joke. CJ Industries must present an environment bond well into the hundreds of thousands, and failure to comply must be in line with the Fisheries Act, ie very heavy fines, closing quarry for a period of time etc. If they say they are a 'good environmental company" then this would not be a problem for them, as they will always comply.

yet proposed monitoring of 1 in every 50 truckloads of material (i.e. 2% by total volume) hardly seems adequate. Assurance is given that the backfill material will comprise only natural materials, pre-screened for contaminants and organic content off site by the Applicant or by its contractors to ensure compliance with Class 5 Landfill standards. Without evidence of past performance I am unconvinced that the Applicant can maintain the required environmental standards.

Pit inundation has been identified by the Applicant as a significant risk. The Applicant advises that this risk would be minimised by gravel excavations between 1m and 0.3m of groundwater levels only being undertaken during dry conditions, and the backfilling of pits would be undertaken within the same day as extraction. This would seem to be a precarious assurance for the following reasons:

1. Effects of climate change are undeniable and sudden, severe rainfall events are to be expected and exposed infill material will periodically be subjected to inundation with consequent contamination of groundwater. Heavy machinery would need to be evacuated from the immediate area and infill material could remain exposed for several days.
2. The lower Motueka Valley aquifer structure is complex and water table levels can be highly variable. Infill material deposited to within 0.3m of the water table can rapidly become submerged by rising water levels.
3. The Applicant's water quality testing is essentially limited to downgradient bores implying that any site toxicity would have a limited impact however the Motueka River Integrated Catchment Management Study explains that the ecosystem of the Motueka catchment and adjacent marine area is one environmental entity and localised events at any point in the river can impact both upstream and downstream river health.
4. The site operations are entirely dependent on the availability of heavy machinery and suitably qualified and inducted operators. It is not hard to imagine situations of machinery breakdowns and (in a post COVID world) where staff are unavailable to work.

CONCLUSION

The Motueka River is a taonga. It is subject to a Water Conservation Order in order to protect its outstanding trout fishery, its amenity, ecological, cultural and scenic values. The WCO is also an aspirational document that should inspire greater protection for the River in the sad times we are now experiencing with increasing threats to biodiversity through continual environmental degradation, both regionally and Worldwide. Adverse climatic events in recent times, exacerbated by poor land management practices, have caused severe environmental impacts to the River and to the marine environment. In an enlightened World there should be zero tolerance for proposed developments which have the probability - inevitability even - of causing adverse environmental impacts.

If the Discharge Permit is consented there will be toxic discharges from backfill material and from general/diffuse site contamination into the ground and surface waters of the Motueka River, the question is how much and how frequently. These risks are unacceptable and are such that I do not believe intended site management practices and monitoring protocols can adequately minimise, mitigate or eliminate.

I urge Council to decline this consent application in the interests of present and future generations.

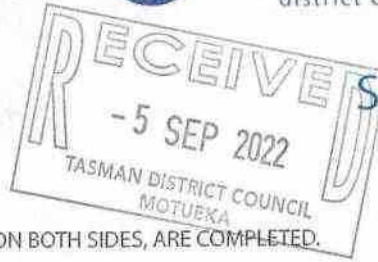



a) The TDC Consultant Planner stated in her s.42A Report that the backfill quality was "crucial to avoid adverse effects on groundwater quality". I have no confidence in the ability of the site manager of the Applicant to examine and approve every truck load of backfill to ensure quality during the intended term of the consent.

b) Many truck loads of backfill will be delivered by contractors over whom the Applicant will have no control either as to the quality of what they deliver, nor the way, or the route, they drive their trucks to the site.

c) A natural consequence of the lack of control referred to in (b), is that contractors who are not subject to rules imposed in the Applicant's Resource Consent will take the shortest route to the site. This might be along Motueka River West Bank Road from the Brooklyn end instead of via Alexander Bluff Bridge as the Applicants trucks will be required to do. This will greatly increase the danger to local residents and all cyclists who use the road, as the first 4 or 5 kms of that road from Brooklyn are particularly narrow and winding.
