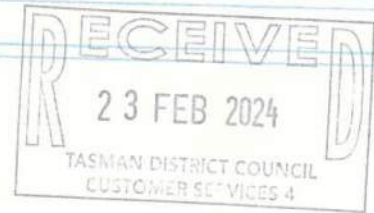



The existing viewing platform will become obsolete changing the nature of the current layout. What is the height of the proposed ramp compared to the viewing platform?

The poem etched into the concrete and written by a local poet will not be readable and will have no meaning as half will be gone.

The proposed building does not comply with height and coastal building restrictions for that area. The view of the estuary will be majorly obstructed by the building.

How will they be able to build foundations / sewer / wastewater without breaking the cap of the contaminated soil .

Doesn't the stormwater have to go below the capped layer.

There will be increased traffic of big vehicles and boat trailers through the village along a village street particularly during the holiday season.



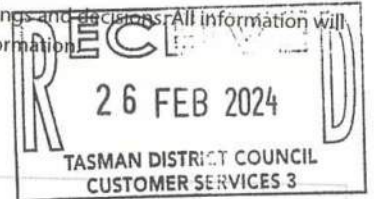

In the traffic report there is no reference made to additional boat traffic from Richmond, Brightwater or Wakefield. There should be. With the hold ups in Nelson and the extra time to get there Mapua will have the problem of extra boaties trying to launch here. I am aware some come from Wakefield to Grossi Point as it is.

The final paragraph in the application refers to "the boat ramp benefiting the wider community". That is a very general statement because if you are not a boatie where is the benefit? You have a smaller green space and a great deal more traffic at a time of the year that is already busy.

There is no reference to the number of trees or other structures that have to be removed. How is any soil disturbance going to be mitigated in those circumstances?

The plan of the ramp shows a width of 11 metres at the start of the slipway. I could not find a measurement at the turnaround area which is wider, intruding into the green space further than the ramp.

Should the ramp proceed how does machinery propose to be used? There should be no further intrusion onto the green space for any construction purposes.

2) The reasons for my submission are (Give details*):

The boat ramp is proposed being built on an open space area of land considered greenspace recreational. Little progress has been made in fully developing the area as for years there has been hesitation due to the possibility of the Boat Club seeking a ramp in the vicinity.

The capped land as i understand it cannot be broken or most certainly should not be broken and it would appear the 40metre slipway must also create disturbance in the area between tide levels creating discharge into the tidal area.

There appears to be no consideration given or shown to what happens to the concrete seating that contains the commencement of a poem created for the seating and area or for restoring any balance to the area that it currently has.

I note the "Sea Scout building": is not their building at all, there is reference in one document to a lease back from the Boat Club. On that basis what is the time frame for the building's construction?

Is it necessary to have a massive gravelled area for boats and trailer parking? Considering the general seasonal use of recreational boats it appears a waste of a good grassed area.



This Consent is to replace an existing boat ramp. It is not a new facility for the area.

Having access to the sea is an important safety, recreational and educational necessity for a seaside community to maintain.

Tasman District Council owe the Boat Club/Community a boat ramp, which has been acknowledged by Tasman District Council granting the Club \$770,000 towards such a facility.

When Tasman District Council designed Mapua Waterfront Park the replacement ramp should have been included. This is very poor planning at its best! ... complete lack of foresight?

There are a number of concerns being raised. We have property in close proximity to a boat ramp we would like to comment on concerns re noise and congestion.

Okiwi Bay Boat Ramp, built by our Community is within 60 – 80 metres of our property and we share one boundary with the boat trailer Park.

Okiwi Bay is a small seaside village with very narrow roads. On a very busy day there can be 120 plus boat trailers in the Park. Problems are very seldom, regarding congestion.

The noise aspect from this activity is very minor and most of the time boat trailers come and go unnoticed/unheard.

The major advantage of Okiwi Bay the Boat Trailer Park is that it is in effect a green open space as the area sits vacant for the majority of time.

The Park is used by all community, including people exercising dogs, children riding their bikes, youths learning to ride 4 wheel motorbikes, teenagers learning to drive.

FENZ Rural Fire group also use it for training.

Mapua is a coastal village which attracts many water activities ... always has, and always should! ... and we must not forget Tasman District Council closed the existing ramp with a promise that it would be reinstated.

As the demand at Nelson and Motueka is already high, there' is a real need for further capacity in our region.

We are hopeful that an independent Commissioner/s who are not members of the Local Authority will take part and be included in this important decision.

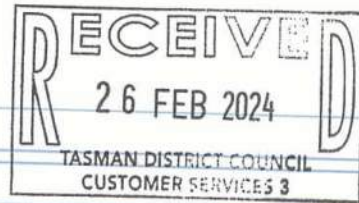
