

Water Shortage Direction

Section 329 of the Resource Management Act 1991

Domestic water use within any water management zone during periods of water rationing in that zone is restricted:

No watering of lawns or decorative gardens is permitted.

Stock drinking water is not restricted.

Stage 1 Rationing which is a 20% cut from authorised weekly usage will **commence** from **Monday 01 March 2021** for the holders of consents who are in the following Water Management Zones

Moutere Western, Glen Rae, Stanley Brook, Tapawera, Tadmor, Baton, Wangapeka, Waimea Delta, Waimea Delta (Un-affiliated), Waimea Delta (Affiliated), Waimea Golden Hills, Golden Hills (Affiliated), Golden Hills (Un-affiliated), Redwood, Waimea Reservoir, Waimea Reservoir (Affiliated), Reservoir (Unaffiliated), Waimea Upper Confined Aquifer, Upper Confined Aquifer (Affiliated), Upper Confined (Un-affiliated), Waimea Upper Catchments, Upper Catchments (Affiliated), Upper Catchments (Un-affiliated), Waimea West, Waimea West (Affiliated) Waimea West (Un-affiliated).

It is important Consent holders are familiar with Resource Consent conditions
